HOW TO ENTER

1 REGISTER & PAY:
Fill out the online form and pay the entry fee of INR 500 via the redirected payment page.

2 PREPARE YOUR FILES:
Take a clear photo/scan of the poster and a photo of the participant holding the poster in landscape format (JPG/PNG <1MB).

3 UPLOAD:
Upload the images along with a valid ID proof (Birth Certificate, Passport, or Student ID) and the transaction number.

SUBMISSION DEADLINE:
All registrations and poster uploads must be completed by 31 May '26.

EVALUATION & AWARDS

5 EQUAL JUDGING CRITERIA (20% each):
Relevance to Theme, Originality, Creativity, Artistic Composition, and Message Conveyed.

THE WINNERS' CIRCLE:
Each category awards a Winner, 1st Runner Up, and 2nd Runner Up with a Trophy and Certificate.

OUTSTANDING RECOGNITION:
10 additional 'Inspiring and Outstanding' posters per category will receive Medals and Certificates.

PARTICIPATION REWARDS:
Every single participant receives a certificate, and schools with 50+ participation get a School Trophy and Teacher Appreciation Trophy.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS & RULES

ACCEPTABLE MEDIUMS:
Use pencils, crayons, watercolors, or oil paints; digital submissions and hand-drawn sketches are also welcome.



PROHIBITED ITEMS:
Do not use photographs, print-outs, or templates; the work must be 100% original and handmade.

ONE ENTRY PER PERSON:
Each participant may submit only one poster, multiple entries will lead to disqualification.

IDEAS TO EXPLORE AROUND THE THEME

Nursery/Kindergarten:

"Little Hands Can Help"
Visuals should focus on small actions like sharing toys, watering plants, helping parents, and keeping surroundings clean.



Grades 1-3:

"Be a Kind and Caring Citizen"
Focus on good behavior such as respecting elders, following traffic rules, helping friends, and protecting animals.



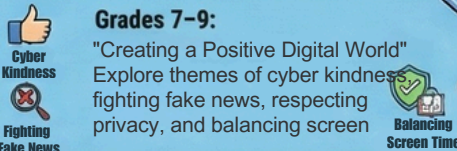
Grades 4-6:

"Protecting Our Planer Starts With Me"
Illustrations should depict individual responsibility like saving water/electricity, reducing plastic, and planting trees.



Grades 7-9:

"Creating a Positive Digital World"
Explore themes of cyber kindness, fighting fake news, respecting privacy, and balancing screen time.



Grades 10-12:

"Innovate. Lead. Transform."

Focus on the future through Ethical Technology, Social Entrepreneurship, Climate Innovation, and AI for good.
